Dear Parents/Carers

Plymstock School intends to run a Sponsored Walk on Friday 30 June 2017 for your child. We anticipate that the day will be a fantastic community event that will bring together all members of both our school and the wider community.

We intend to use the proceeds to support the student enrichment programme that we operate throughout the year benefiting student activities, providing additional opportunities and rewarding positive student behaviour. We also intend to use the fund to improve the school environment for students at break and lunchtimes.

The walk will depart from school after morning registration and follow a 10 mile route from school around the boundary of Saltram Park and back. We would like all students to have the opportunity to take part in the walk and have designed an alternative route for students who are physically unable to complete the distance that is also suitable for wheelchairs.

The students will be required to walk in small groups and get an individual passport stamped 6 times en-route to ensure they are safe and complete the allocated route in the appropriate manner. In addition, staff will be walking the route interspersed amongst the students.

- 2. A one off £10 payment per family payable via ParentPay by Friday 16 June**
If you have not received your activation code to access your ParentPay account or you have any queries about paying by ParentPay please contact the Finance office.
- 3. Failure to meet either of these deadlines will unfortunately mean that your child will potentially have to remain in school and not participate in the Sponsored Walk.**
