Using your Plymstock School Google account you need to join the new Google Classroom titled 2020 - A Level Computer Science using the class code: o5ugic
Once in this classroom you will find your summer work task. This is to learn about the **Structure and Function of the Processor**.

You are provided with an evidence document to complete. It provides you with objectives that you need to meet but is not prescriptive about the way you present this as you may use prose, bullet points images or any other means you like.

Also within the document are links to a wide range of online resources to help you master this topic before our first lesson. This topic will be one of the major parts of your first test in Y12 so it is vital that you put in sufficient time to learn the content. I would suggest 2 hours as a minimum for learning the content and another 1.5 – 2 hours to complete your SLE.

For those of you who have not used Google Classroom before you should be aware that we are able to see how much time you have put into the SLE as the system logs the time you have been working on it and when.
