What does the Government's announcement on 'school closure' mean for Plymstock School?

Many parents/carers will have learnt of Boris Johnson's announcement that once the school day finishes on Friday 20 March that all schools will be closed for the foreseeable future except for vulnerable children and those children of key workers.

At the present moment, we have not been given any more detail as to what kind of educational service schools are being asked to provide as from Monday 23 March. As soon as I receive more guidance from the government, I will work with my staff to do the very best I can to provide a continued educational offer – both to pupils who will be working from home and those who may be attending school.

I recognise that as parents/carers you will have many questions about what will happen in the coming days, weeks and possibly months. In due course I am confident that we will be able to answer those questions and provide reassurance as to how we will continue to look after the educational interests of all our children. We will continue to use email/MyEd, our website to update you with our plans as soon as practically possible.
