Dear Year 10 Parent / Carer

Further to my letter yesterday which outlined initial planning for Year 10 provision in the summer term, I wish to draw your attention to the following updates.

Safety

Under the current guidelines for Social Distancing, we have conducted a Risk Assessment and now know that most classrooms will only accommodate 8 students. This, together with the need to ensure that these classrooms are cleaned regularly, means that we feel that we can only offer Face to Face learning in short sessions, most likely 2 hours, on a limited number of days. When we have finalised the logistics we will send out the safety procedures that all students and staff must follow, when on site. These will include arrangements such as different start and finishing times for different groups of students.

Face to Face Learning

We are currently planning on a programme of sessions which will be delivered by a subject specialist; initially these will only be in English, Mathematics and Science. These sessions will be subject specific and delivered by a subject specialist; we cannot guarantee that this teacher will be the student's subject teacher.

We will ensure that the resources for these lessons are made available to any student who is unable to attend school.

We are still waiting on further Secondary-specific guidance from the Government, which was originally due to be released on Friday 15 May. We hope that this will further clarify their plans for Face to Face learning for this year group and we will share our final plans once we have received this.
