Please add your full name to the email.

Alternatively, we can send your results through the post. These will not be posted until results day so you will **not** receive your results until a day or so later, depending on the post.

If your parents/carers currently don't have MyEd please contact Beckie so she can check contact details on the system and give you guidance on downloading the app.

Both of us will be available on results day, but this will be via telephone. If you need to speak to us on this day either telephone us on: 07375 925339 or 07515 867584. Alternatively, you can email either of us with your contact telephone number and we will get back to you as soon as possible. Keeping checking your school emails as we will be sending further information, including information from Beckie about clearing and adjustment nearer the time. UCAS are also sending out lots of useful information so please read these emails. Beckie is available on MS Teams to support, email or telephone if you have any questions before hand.

We will, along with Gemma also be looking at how we can celebrate your time in Sixth Form. With the cancellation of the summer ball, we still want to do something to see you all again at some point. Obviously, this still depends on how the social restrictions currently in place are eased for us to be able to do this safely.
