# Online Learning

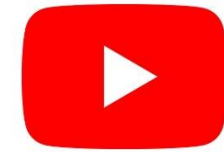


Once again we are **ALL** having to spend more time online. This is because this is where our school learning is having to take place.

We **MUST** make sure that we are staying safe and if we have any worries, we know what to do

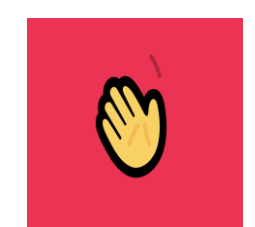
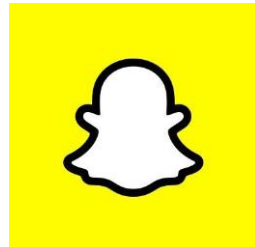


# Online Learning – School Platforms

# Online Learning – Personal Platforms



## **STAYING SAFE**

- Think before you post
- Don't share personal details
- Watch out for phishing and scams
- Know who you're talking to
- Keep your device secure
- Never give out your password



# What to do if I am worried?

## **Talk to someone that you trust**

This could be someone like your tutor, teacher, Head of Year or member of the safeguarding team. You can also tell your parents

## **Report any online bullying or abuse**

You can do this directly with the website or app. You can also report it to a member of staff at school. Bullying or abusive behaviours in any form **MUST** not be tolerated

## **Tell the Police**

If you are the victim of any form of threatening behaviour or blackmail, you should report it to CEOP

## **Plan for the future**

Check and change your privacy settings so that it does not happen again
