Dear Parent/Carer

Re: Restless Excellence – Standards and Expectations

I am taking the opportunity to write to you to provide you with further information regarding our continuing moves to support our students to re-establish themselves back into the structures, routines and rules at Plymstock School.

Since Monday 7 June, our Year 10 students have been attending school wearing their full school uniform on a daily basis. On the days, they have PE, they have brought their PE kit to school and changed in the changing rooms. This has proved to be a success and I would like to thank the PE team for supporting this and the students who have taken full responsibility in ensuring they are adhering to the standards and expectations we place on them.

As of **Monday 5 July**, Years 7, 8 and 9 students will be expected to follow suit and change for PE in the changing rooms. Students will **NOT** be allowed to wear any other kit other than the items listed within the school policy. It will also mean that students will be expected to wear their full school uniform every day. **There will no longer be any need for students in Year 7, 8 and 9 to wear PE kit to school.**

Please remember that pupils are expected to wear their school blazer at all times whilst on site. In the case of hot weather, we will inform the students of the decision for a 'non-blazer' day. Pupils are NOT to wear hoodies or other non-school uniform related items. In lessons, pupils are required to remove coats, however they may wish to wear coats to and from school in case of inclement weather. They may choose to wear the school jumper (with school badge) as an optional addition but this cannot be worn in place of the blazer, only in addition.

Just a reminder that we strongly advise that all uniform and PE kit is clearly labelled with the child's name in case it is lost or misplaced.
