Dear Parent/Carer

RE: Transition Programme - Plymstock School

I wanted to take the opportunity to write to you to share some information regarding some further events that we are now in a position to offer the children who will be joining us in September. You may be aware that my colleagues Mrs M Kirk and Mr P Chivers, along with our SEND department, have been very busy hosting enhanced transition days, parental visits, virtual meetings with students and visiting some of our local schools to share information about Plymstock School with your children.

Due to COVID-19 restrictions, our normal transition programme has been slightly disrupted. However, I am delighted to inform you that after recently reviewing our COVID-19 risk assessment and systems of control, we are in a position to provide an on-site induction day for all the children that will be joining us in September.

I can confirm that the following dates have been booked for the children to attend a day's induction at Plymstock School. We have shared this information with your child's primary school.


