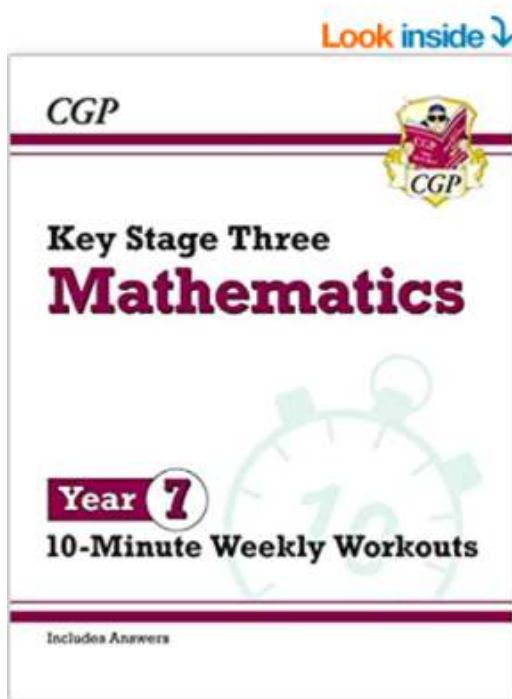




How can you help?

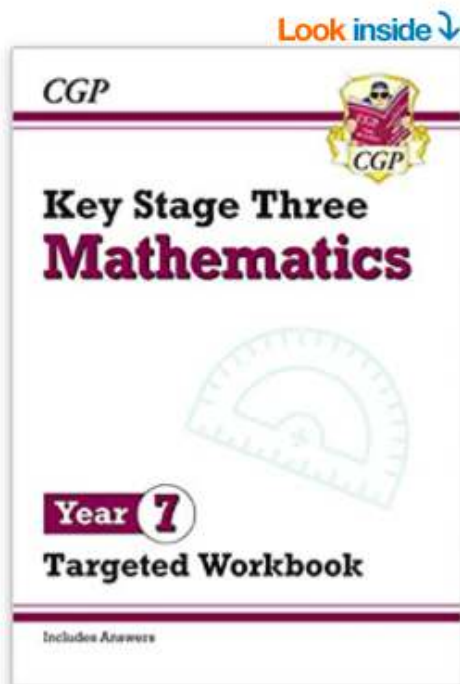






They also have
