Headteacher Update

In an effort to improve our communication between school and home, I will be writing to you all every fortnight to provide you with key updates on what is happening within our school community, including recognising the successes of our students and staff and sharing forthcoming events.

Related to the importance of effective communication, I would like to thank those parents/carers who have contacted the school regarding the purchase of PE kit. We are currently in the final stages of securing a new supplier. I will write to you all with further details in the next couple of weeks but I would like to reassure you that the current PE kit will not need to be replaced. We have looked at securing a new supplier to support our commitment to lower uniform costs and make it easier to order. In the short term, where a replacement kit or item is required but cannot be purchased, plain black alternatives will be permitted (with a note).

We have had a busy start to the Spring term, and I thank everyone who attended our Post 16 evening last week and our Year 9 Options evening last night. Both of these events were very well attended and I thank my colleagues for providing such valuable and helpful information.
