

JOIN PLYMOUTH'S POPPY MAKING COMMUNITY

This year Plymouth City Council is planning to create a poppy wave that will be displayed on the front of the Council House in the city centre during the lead-up to Remembrance Sunday.

We are asking you to join us in remembering the city's fallen heroes by making poppies from any weatherproof material, for example felt or wool (not paper).

Become part of Plymstock School's 'Plymouth Poppy Making Community'.
We will have a craft club running on Tuesday Break 2 in Hu7 to help create our poppies. Or you can make some at home.

The poppies will be added to a large camouflage net that will be attached to the Council House balcony, forming a wave of poppies.
