All activities require a non-refundable deposit. We accept instalments for higher cost activities.

SPECIAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE WEEK

<u>Meals</u>

Packed lunches for off site activities will be provided if your child normally has a free school meal.

<u>Clothing</u>

Students can wear casual clothes during the week. Extreme styles and jewellery will not be allowed. Information about clothing for the various activities will be provided by the trip leaders nearer the time.

The following residential trips are bookable via deposit payment on Parent Pay from 4pm on Monday 13th November. Please also complete the option form at the back of this booklet - this will help me to keep friendship groups together and manage reserve spaces.

Residential to Paris

Visit Paris and experience the theme parks. Letter explaining details sent via MyEd. Places can be booked via a deposit on Parent Pay.

Residential to Extreme Cornwall

Visit Cornwall for sun sea and surfing. Letter explaining details sent via MyEd. Places can be booked via a deposit on Parent Pay.

Residential to Penzance

Visit Cornwall for sun sea and adventure. Letter explaining details sent via MyEd. Places can be booked via a deposit on Parent Pay.

Residential to PGL Barton Hall Torquay

Students will take part in a range of activities including for example climbing, zip wire, swimming and challenges. Letter explaining details sent via MyEd. Places can be booked via a deposit on Parent Pay.

Residential to London

Visit London. Plus a day at Thorpe park. Letter explaining details sent via MyEd. Places can be booked via a deposit on ParentPay.

Daily Activities and Trips

Active Mix

Mixed sport - 1 day on site and 4 days off site - Woodlands, off site walk, skateboarding at Prime & swimming at QuayWest.

Creative Mix

A week of activities across a range of skills. Activities will include: Art Photography, Technology, Film & Cooking.

Community Reading Project

Spend the week writing and creating your own children's book to read to children at some of our local primary schools. We will be crafting story sacks and making puppet resources to help tell stories. Then we will share our stories with children in local reception and Year 1 classes. We will be doing some 'Silver Reading' and will be visiting local residential homes to read and share books with the elderly people in our community. This will earn you a *Plymstock Community Citizenship Award*.

Dartmoor walks

Join us for walks on Dartmoor. We will spend time learning about safety procedures on the moors and route planning. We drive onto the moors to complete walks and have a picnic lunch. You will need to be ready for long walks and extreme weather. You will need to bring a picnic & carry enough water to last you all day. There will be nowhere to buy food and drinks on our walks and there will be limited access to toilets.

<u>Football</u>

Enhance your knowledge of football with Plymouth Argyle coaches. There will be the opportunity to play a range of different football games and formats including: street soccer, futsal and mini soccer. The focus will be on game play, theory, officiating and organisation to improve overall performance. The week will be based at school on our 3G pitches and will include a visit to Plymouth Argyle's ground at Home Park.

<u>Fishing</u>

Learn how to fish and use equipment. Then use your skills fishing at a local coarse fishing lake. Angling in waters that hold carp that weigh up to 25lb and various other smaller species. This activity would suit either students with fishing experience and own equipment, or complete beginners. Transport each day will be included as well as 4 days with 4 hours a day fishing time. All you will need to bring is yourself, your lunch and some patience.

Knowledge Mix

We will spend a week exploring people and places, words and number. With 3 days on site activities. This will also include 2 days off site - Eden Project and Paignton Zoo.

Musical Theatre Performance Workshop

Love Musical Theatre? Then spend the week working on songs from your favourite West End and Broadway musicals. During the week you will learn how a musical is put together, from Les Miserables to Mary Poppins, how actors rehearse and learn lines, develop stamina through warm ups and dance routines and discover how fantastic it can be to create your own musical theatre performance.

<u>Rugby</u>

Enhance your knowledge of Rugby. There will be the opportunity to play a range of different games and formats. The focus will be on game play, theory, officiating and organisation to improve overall performance. The week will be based at school using our rugby field, gym and computers.

Ski centre - skiing slope style

Spend a week at the Plymouth Ski centre learning to ski and snowboard either as a beginner trying a brand new challenge or an experienced skier challenging yourself to improve your skills. All skiing equipment is included and you will also spend après-ski time snow-tubing, tobogganing and dropping in on the Viper Run throughout the week.

<u>Surfing</u>

Learn how to respect the water and learn to surf or further develop your surfing skills whilst working with qualified instructors. A week of sun, and surf at Discovery Surf School, Bigbury Beach. For complete beginners or more advanced surfers, the qualified instructors will be there to push your surfing to the next level.

<u>Transport</u>

We will visit nationally recognised museums for collections of Aircraft and Cars. We will also visit local heritage Railway museums to get a behind the scenes look at their role in preserving old engines and rolling stock. Our days may be longer than usual school times.

<u>Trips mix</u>

The week will be spent participating in a variety of activities at various venues which will include physical & mental challenges as well as the opportunity to enjoy the South West tourist sites. Included are a day at the following venues: Eden Project, Paignton Zoo, Woodlands, River Dart and Quay West.

<u>Warhammer</u>

Students would receive an army box from Games Workshop. We would spend the week building, painting and gaming with those armies. We would have one day in the Warhammer Store in Plymouth City Centre where they would run a range of sessions on hobby skills and how to play the games.

Water Sports

Spend the week having fun learning how to stay water safe and take part in a variety of water based activities with specialist trainers. You will experience activities like paddle boarding and dinghy sailing.

Wellbeing mix

Everyone will take part in a few things not tried before in a supported small group environment. Activities offered include: Origami, Board Games, Puzzles, Video Games, Books, Knitting, Painting, Coding, Drawing, Creative Writing, Quizzes, Making Music, Cloud Watching, Cross stich and Colouring.

BEHAVIOUR

At Plymstock School we have high expectations of the behaviour of our students when off the school premises. In such cases, we cannot guarantee that a refund will be provided.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

We are aware of the potential hazards involved in adventure activities. It can sometimes be difficult, almost impossible, to create an opportunity for challenge whilst totally eliminating all risks. We hear of schools withdrawing from all types of such activity because of the risk of some unforeseen danger or threat to the wellbeing of their children.

The staff involved in organising the activities have paid great attention to health and safety and some activities have been modified as a consequence. Where activities take place in a potentially hazardous environment, tuition and supervision by properly qualified instructors have been arranged. In situations where teachers at the school possess appropriate qualifications, their expertise is being fully employed to provide children with real adventure at reduced costs. Every activity included has been examined for health and safety and adequate staff/ student ratios. As a result we can confidently offer a wide range of activities which are within the Education Authority's strict safety guidelines.
