

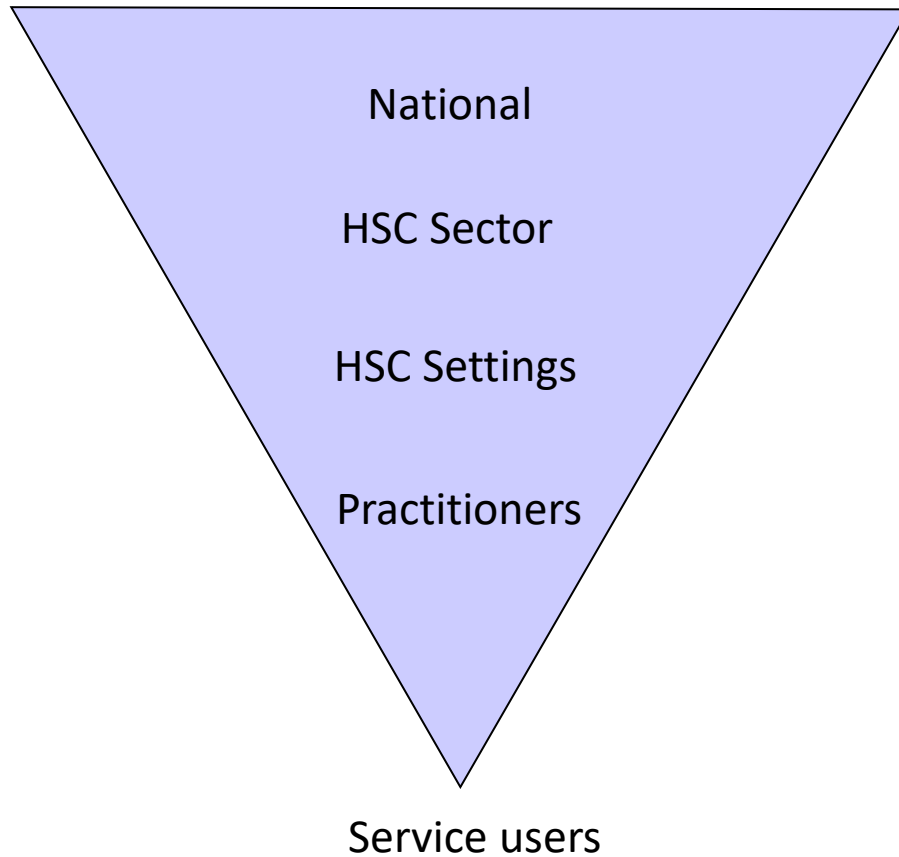

- Early Years – nursery classes (in schools), private nurseries, playgroups, creches (0-8)
