




Andorra







The day of the trip...

Please park in the main carpark and make you way to the Galley Area. In terms of luggage:

- 1: One Suitcase which will be kept in the hold.
- 2: One item of hand luggage for the cabin.

When you arrive find your group leader and give them your 2 envelopes and your medication

- Envelope 1: Passport and EHIC/GHIC card
- Envelope 2: Pocket money (please keep a small amount of Euro's and £'s on your for the journey).
- Any medication (this will go into the medical bag anything that you will need during the journey must be made very clear to your group leader and still in its original packaging with instructions).
- If you have ever suffered from travel sickness please ensure that you have taken medication or are wearing travel bands and have also brought enough for the rest of the journey and the return journey.













TRAVELLING BY COACH

We will be travelling to resort in an executive coach; our coach has toilet facilities are contractually fitted with seat belts.

The drivers will have experience of continental driving.

During daylight hours and in the early evening you can talk sensibly, but remain in your seats, you will also be allowed your phone and electronic devices. There will be videos to lighten the journey. After midnight the lights will be put out and you will be expected to be silent to allow those who want to sleep the opportunity to do so.

The **Resort Manager** will meet us at our hotel and help us get settled into our rooms.


We will then go to the **ski hire shop** and collect our equipment!

- We have organised 5 hours of ski school per day














What to pack... Ski Clothing

- Thermal vest/t-shirt/rash vest;
- Microfleece
- Swimwear
